Enter your search term in the **Find** field above and click **Search**. A visual map is presented and contains:

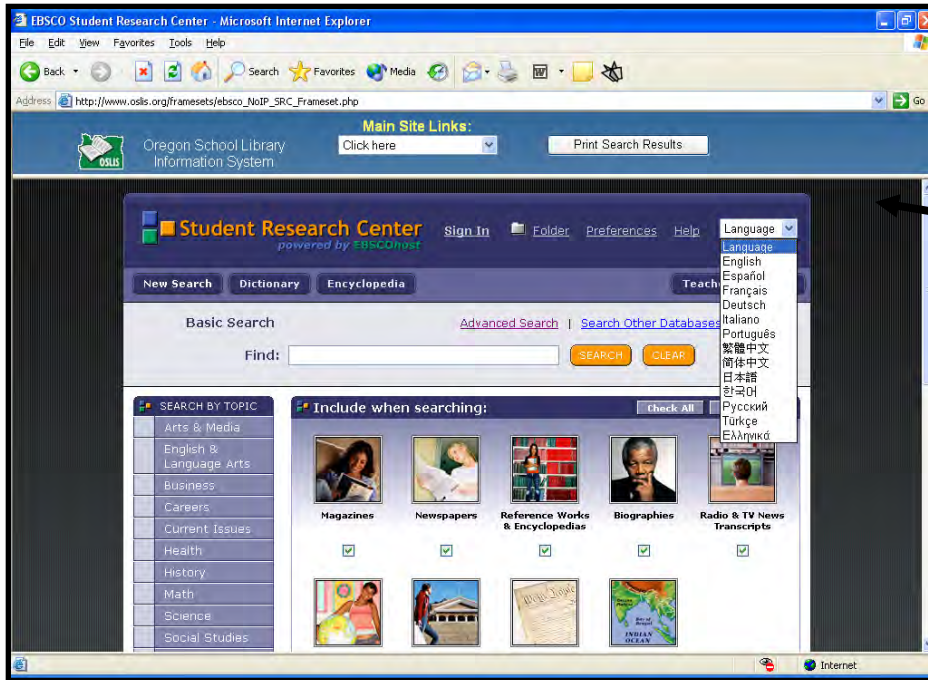
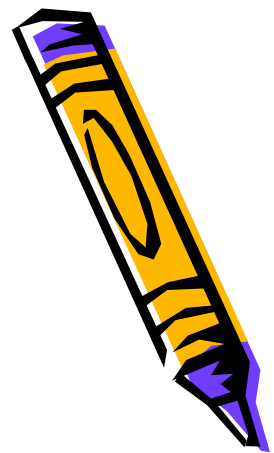
- **Circles**, which represent categories of results. Categories can include subcategory circles. Click on a circle (category) to explore its contents.

To move back (or up) in the map, click outside of a circle or square. Click on **Top** to view the entire map.

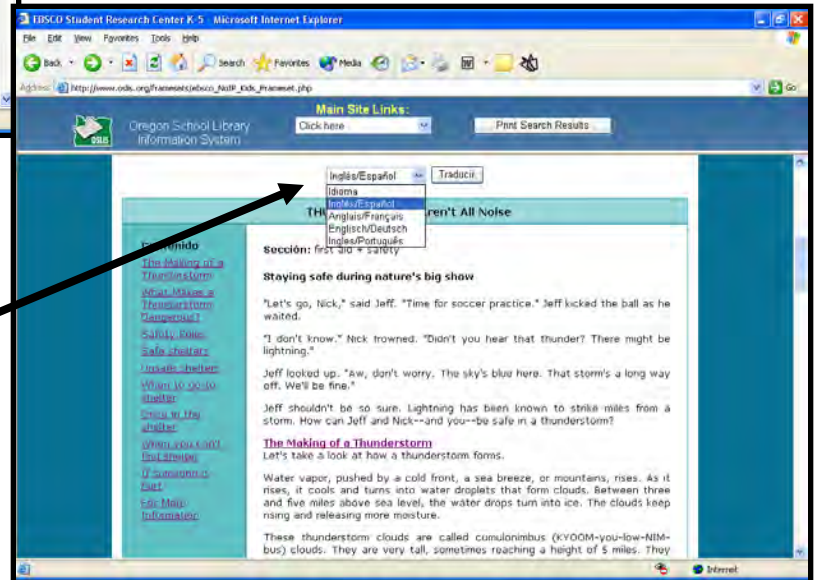
